## Aquatic Plant Profile

Azolla Caroliniana, a member of the Azollaceae family, is a free-floating aquatic fern. It also goes by other names, such as Fairy Moss, Water Velvet, and Carolina Mosquito Fern. The Water Fern floats on the surface, with its root system hanging in the water. It has no flowers, and remains green in a shaded environment, but reddish in full sun or in the fall. Fish love to nibble this plant! It can also be used as an aquarium plant. The Water



Fern is a good naturalizer in ponds, but quickly colonizes and can get out of control in larger ponds, particularly if its habitat is over a foot deep. In some states, but not in Arizona, Azolla Caroliniana is listed as a noxious weed.
